On Sunday, September 8, our Hispanic Ministry is hosting their 3rd annual International Food Festival in Fremont Hall, from 11:00 AM until 5:00 PM. This year, they hope to expand this Parish fundraiser to include a wide variety of cultural tasting opportunities.

We are looking for volunteers to prepare, donate and serve approximately 50 plates of your favorite international food! Please plan to provide information about what you bring, i.e. dish name, history, ingredients, recipe, etc.

Although final details are still in the works, the plan is to have patrons pay a small entrance fee. This fee will entitle you to a few sampling tickets. Tickets can be redeemed at the food tables to "purchase" the food samples. Each sample will require a different number of tickets based on the size and complexity of the food item. Additional tickets will be available for purchase once you are inside the event.

Please note that the food must be cooked offsite. Although some preparation can be done when you arrive, table space may be limited depending on the number of participants. Set-up for the event will begin at 8:00 AM. The festival starts at 11 AM and be over by 5 PM.

Walking into a Church

When entering the church for Mass, Catholics typically perform a series of rituals. They may greet people they see. They cross the threshold

that separates the outside world from the church. They may pick up the parish bulletin or a religious newspaper. They dip their hand in holy water and make the sign of the cross. They approach the place where they will sit. They genuflect. They enter the seat, where they may kneel for a few moments, perhaps making the sign of the cross again during the genuflection or on taking their place. Many Catholics do all this even if they arrive late for the liturgy.

The *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* says very little about how Catholics should enter the church. Most of these particular rituals have derived from custom rather than law.

Of all these gestures, the instruction makes only some brief comments about the respect shown the altar and the tabernacle. If the tabernacle is in the sanctuary, the ministers genuflect to it at the beginning and the end of Mass, but not during it. "Otherwise, all who pass before the Most Blessed Sacrament genuflect, unless they are moving in procession" (274). "A bow of the body, that is to say a profound bow, is made to the altar" (275).and

Upon entering the church, Catholics should either genuflect or bow. They genuflect to the tabernacle if it is in the sanctuary. If it is not, they make a bow of the body toward the altar before taking their place.



Why we sing...

"Singing is the sign of the heart's joy" (*General Instruction of the Roman Missal* 39). When we praise God at Mass each Sunday, we come with a joyful heart. We are grateful for the gift of life and all our many blessings. We leave the comfort of our homes and bring ourselves to church, where we gather with others who have made the same sacrifice. There we do something we may not normally do. We sing.

Singing has been a part of Mass ever since the Last Supper (Mt 26:30). The first Christians sang psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (Col 3:16). We echo them.

"Great importance should therefore be attached to the use of singing in the celebration of the Mass" (GIRM 40). Our songs are formed by the rhythms and melodies of old traditions and contemporary cultures. They help us express the joy in our hearts—as well as our sadness, our wonderment, and our hope.

Every one is invited to sing at every Mass. "[E]very care should be taken that singing by the ministers and the people not be absent in celebrations that occur on Sundays and on Holy days of Obligation" (GIRM 40). Some parishes have a Sunday Mass at which no singing occurs, but the church asks us to avoid this. Music belongs at every Mass. It helps us participate with body, soul, mind, and strength.

One of the purposes of the opening hymn is to "foster the unity of those who have been gathered" (47). When you arrive at church, heart filled with joy, you express your faith in God and your unity with others in a beautiful way. You open your mouth. And sing.
