Natural Family Planning Classes (NFP)

NFP is an umbrella term for certain methods used to achieve and avoid pregnancies. NFP reflects the dignity of the human person within the context of marriage and family life, promotes openness to life, and recognizes the value of the child. By respecting the love-giving and life-giving natures of marriage, NFP can enrich the bond between husband and wife.

Natural Family Planning classes will be taught by members from the Couple to Couple League in a series of 3 classes. To provide flexibility to couples due to where they live, classes will be held in two locations. Classes at St. Margaret of Scotland, Newark, Delaware will begin on September 10th at 1:00 PM. Classes at St. John the Apostle in Milford, Delaware begin September 3rd at 9:00 AM. The method taught, Sympto-Thermal, is safe and highly effective. Our Parish will hold Evening Vespers at Holy Angels Church on Sunday, September 11, 2011, at 6:30 PM.

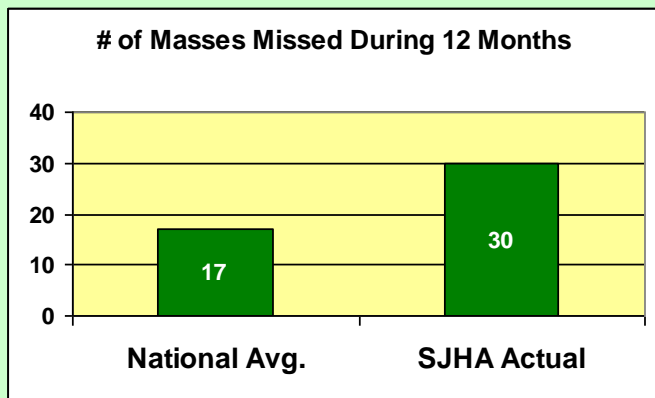

Online Giving – Progress Report

Since we started evaluating Online Giving in this parish, parishioners have asked these two questions continually: (1) why do we need online giving? and (2) how many people really miss Mass each week? We now have the answer to #2.

How many people miss Mass at SJHA?



Important notes about analysis:

- SJHA number is based on collections in last fiscal year (July 2010 – June 2011).
- It appears that approximately 20% of our donating community donates once a month. Consequently, the SJHA number has been adjusted accordingly.
- During the July-June period, there were 1,137 registered families who made 21,109 donations for a total of \$756,000. Average weekly offertory donation was \$35.81. However, 70% of all donations are under \$25.
- While most registered parishioners make a donation when they attend Mass, occasionally they forget their envelope. Consequently, the number of Masses missed might be more in the range of 28-30 missed Masses.

Why is this important to know?

Because this is one of the biggest reasons why our parish is experiencing financial challenges. Please do the math. Online Giving could be a significant way for you to re-dedicate yourself to your parish and help us repair and maintain all of our facilities for your worship experience and comfort.
