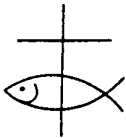

**Prevention Health Screenings** has been coming to our parish for the last 9 years. They offer 8 painless, non-invasive prevention screenings that could save your life. Test results are mailed to you, and you follow up with your own doctor.

### Tests offered are:

1. Heart Disease Risk Screen via IMT
2. Stroke/Carotid Artery Screen
3. Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screen
4. Thyroid Screen
5. Peripheral Arterial Disease
6. Electrocardiogram (EKG) Screen
7. Pulmonary Function Screen
8. Bone Density-Osteoporosis

## Receiving Holy Communion

The following guidelines are based on the norms for the reverent reception of Holy Communion at Mass contained in the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* from the Holy See and in *Norms for the Distribution and Reception of Holy Communion Under Both Kinds in the Dioceses of the United States* issued by the American bishops and confirmed by the Holy See.



1. Stand up and step out of your pew to join in the Communion procession. Put up your kneelers.
2. It is appropriate to join your hands in front of you in a prayerful position (traditionally over the heart) as you process forward.
3. Remain standing to receive Holy Communion. This is the standard posture for receiving Communion in the United States.
4. As the person in front of you is receiving Holy Communion, bow your head and shoulders slightly as a sign of reverence toward Our Lord in the Eucharist. This is the standard posture of reverence in the Diocese of Wilmington before one receives Communion.
5. You may receive the Body of Christ either in your hand or on your tongue. The choice is yours.
6. **If you intend to receive the Body of Christ in your hand...** extend both hands palm upwards toward the minister, placing one hand directly on top of the other. You should do this as you approach the minister so that it is obvious to the minister that you wish to receive Communion in the hand. *"When you approach..." said Saint Cyril of Jerusalem, "place your left hand as a throne beneath your right, as befits one who is about to receive the King. Then receive him, taking care that nothing is lost."* Which hand will be placed beneath the other will be a matter decided by the communicant, who might be left-handed or right-handed.
7. The minister will hold the Body of Christ in front of you and say, "The Body of Christ." You respond by saying, "Amen." The minister will then place the Body of Christ on your open palm. Do not attempt to grab it from the minister with your fingers.
8. Once the Body of Christ has been placed in your hand, step aside (to allow the person behind you to come forward to receive) and immediately consume the Body of Christ as you stand facing toward the Altar. You should pick up the Bread from the palm of your hand with the fingers of your other hand and reverently place the Bread in your mouth. Then either join the procession to receive the Precious Blood from the minister holding the chalice or return respectfully to your pew.
9. **If you are going to receive the Body of Christ on your tongue...** keep your hands joined over your heart as you approach the minister. After the minister holds the Body of Christ in front of you and says "The Body of Christ" and you respond "Amen," open your mouth with your tongue relaxed against the bottom lip and extended far enough for the minister to easily place the Body of Christ on your tongue. Do not attempt to reach for the Bread with your tongue or mouth. Instead, remain still so that the minister will have no difficulty placing the Body of Christ on your tongue.
10. If you wish to receive the Precious Blood - the choice is yours - bow your head and shoulders slightly as the person before you is receiving from the chalice. Approach the minister with your hands joined reverently. The minister will hold the chalice in front of you and say, "The Blood of Christ," to which you respond, "Amen." The minister will then hand you the chalice. Grasp the chalice firmly with both hands and bring it to your lips, taking care not to spill any of the Precious Blood within. Take a small sip of the Precious Blood and hand the chalice back to the minister who will wipe its rim to prepare it for the next communicant.
11. After receiving Holy Communion, return reverently to your pew, kneel, and continue singing the Communion Hymn.
12. We cannot leave Mass yet, for we have yet to acknowledge our thanks to God and receive his blessings at the end of Mass. After all have received Communion, there is an extended period of silence for all to pray. After the silent period of prayer, the priest gathers all of our prayers together. Then, we are blessed in our Mission and most weeks we sing a song of joy as we are sent on our mission as disciples nourished by the Eucharist.

**If you are unable to walk in the Communion Procession because of illness or infirmity, please inform an usher before Mass so that a Communion Minister may bring you Communion.**
