**Food Collection Collaboration  
SJHA and Holy Family  
Food Outreach Office**

During two distribution weeks in January, the Holy Family Food Outreach was able to provide food to 61 families. This is good news, but at this rate the well-stocked shelves can become bare very quickly if donations do not keep pace. Holy Family and the community appreciate all the help we at St. John-Holy Angels are providing. It's fairly easy to remember the Food Collection if you just add some of these items to your family shopping list: instant oatmeal packets, complete pancake mix, syrup, jelly, peanut butter, instant potatoes, canned fruit, pasta sauce, pudding cups. Jesus Himself showed us how good it is to feed the hungry.

**Changes in Communion Flow at Holy Angels**

Beginning with the March 4/5 Masses at Holy Angels, there will be a new flow for receiving communion. This change affects only one section. All other sections will remain the same.

Section A is the area nearest the Ambo, the processional cross, and the EXIT sign. Those in this area will exit the pews to their left rather than their right. There will be an additional communion minister in that section. After receiving communion, you can return to your pew at the side opposite where you exited.

Our hope is that this minor change will simplify the flow in that section.

In addition, ministers from both sides will attempt to reach the handicapped in the pews reserved for them. Just a reminder, if you wish communion to be brought to you, please tell an usher or greeter as you come into church. Thank you!

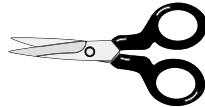

## VII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Primera lectura Levítico 19:1-2, 17-18

Salmo Responsorial 102 "El Señor es compasivo y misericordioso".

Segunda lectura 1 Corintios 3: 16-23

### Evangelio Mateo 5: 38-48

El Evangelio de hoy nos deja ver lo opuesto de la ley mosaica y la doctrina de Jesús. El primer contraste que escuchamos es renunciar al derecho de compensación, tal como lo estipula la ley del talión. Esta ley buscaba acotar la venganza o equilibrar el abuso con esa compensación. En esto va implícita la violencia en mayor o menor grado.

En esta justicia nueva, sin embargo, no solamente hay que desterrar la violencia al precio que sea, hay que ser excesivamente generoso con aquellos que demandan algo incluso injustamente o con el derecho estipulado. La experiencia del reino, requiere del discípulo una actitud pacífica tal que renuncie a la propia defensa ante el ofensor, a ser doblemente generoso con el que obliga a algún servicio al que no tiene derecho. y ser extremadamente generoso con pordioseros y prestar sin condiciones.
