**What is a Parish Mission?**

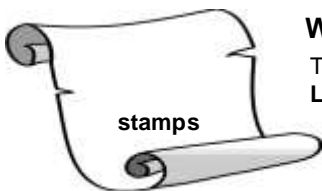

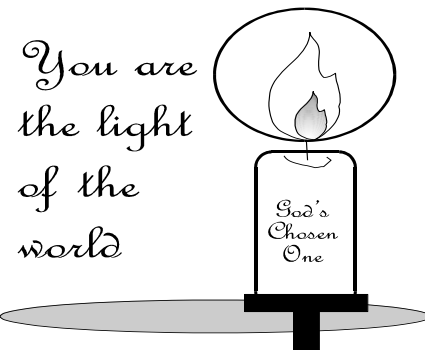
