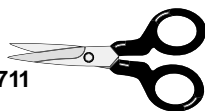

El tiempo es breve, dice el apóstol. Los creyentes le preguntaban sobre el estado de vida: si deberían casarse, separarse los casados por cuestión de apostolado- o permanecer célibes los no casado. Lo que preocupa a Pablo es la aparición del Mesías Jesús que anuncia la irrupción del reino de Dios en la vida presente y que ha relativizado todos los valores humanos. El tiempo es un don de Dios. El tiempo está pegado a las criaturas. Por la Creación Dios sometió a la ley inexorable del Tiempo. Cuando interviene el Señor todo se Condensa, se comprime para recalcar esos momentos. Por eso el Señor acostumbraba decir: "Se ha cumplido el tiempo" (Mc 1:15).

Este tiempo cualitativo empuja a Pablo a Exhortar a sus discípulos a que capten el Significado de cada cosa. Por lo tanto "deben de usar el mundo como si no lo usaran" porque ninguna criatura puede ponerse como obstáculo entre Dios y el hombre, ni puede construir un fin que siempre será Dios. El objetivo de Pablo es tener enfrente una Realidad, Dios se ha acercado al hombre. La respuesta del hombre debe de ir en esta misma dirección.
