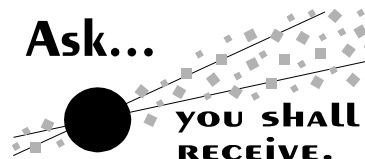

Online Giving – Progress Report

Continuing this week is the latest progress on one of the parish's most important campaigns, Online Giving (OLG).

Online Giving Goals

- Provide ability to make donations when unable to attend SJHA masses.
- Increase parish donations. Reduce envelope costs.
- Simplify year-end tax reporting. Eliminate paper.
- Eliminate hassle of writing checks before (during) mass.
- Reduce weekly task of counting & recording cash / checks.

Program Financial Targets

- Enrollment Target: 1,000 families.
- Avg. Missed Masses at SJHA (annually) per family: 17
- Avg. Weekly Donation of Giving Families: \$15.00
- Goal is to increase annual donations by \$250,000.

Accomplishments To Date...

- SEP 2010 – Finance Council evaluates Online Giving.
- OCT & NOV 2010 – Several vendor proposals are evaluated.
- DEC 2010 – Final recommendation given to Pastor.
- 1Q 2011 – Business contract developed and approved.
- 2Q 2011 – Letter from the Pastor and Recruitment of Nifty 50 appear in bulletin.

- JUL 2011 – Knights of Columbus become 1st Ministry to officially sponsor and support the Online Giving Program.
- AUG 2011 – KOC Social will be dedicated to discuss OLG benefits and enroll early adopters.
