Silence in the Liturgy

- Part I

Silence is an endangered species in most Roman Catholic liturgies today. Contrary to what some may

think, silence does not mean that the priest, deacon, lector, or cantor has dozed off or forgotten what to do! Silence in the liturgy is not meant to be that frustrating void we feel when the audio portion of a TV program goes silent. Yes, words are crucial to the liturgy: words of the songs we sing, Scripture we hear, prayers we pray together. God addresses his Word to us, and we address words to God and to each other. But silence is what helps us discover the meaning and power of all these words. We couldn't hear or appreciate the notes of a piece of music if there weren't the tiniest moment of silence in between them. Silence is a way for the many words of the liturgy to "sink in," to be absorbed in our minds and hearts like rain falling upon the ground well-prepared to receive it. The Church recognizes that silence is endangered in our lives and invites us to moments of silence in our liturgical celebrations. For it is often only in the stillness and the silence that we are able to hear God's voice (1 Kings 19:12).

In the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM)*, we read "Sacred silence also, as part of the celebration, is to be observed at the designated times." This means that silence is an important part of every liturgy. It is called "sacred" for in this silence we meet God, the Holy One. We also meet there the holiness to which each of us is called by our baptism.

In the Mass, the GIRM tells us we are invited to silence at these six times: **(1) before the celebration in the sacristy and adjacent areas (2) at the Act of Penitence, (3) after each time the priest says "Let us pray," (4) after each reading and Psalm, (5) after the homily, and (6) after all have received Communion.**
