**The Roman Missal –
Part 6 in a 7-Part Series**

“So what other responses will change?”

Here are some examples:

In the Gloria, we currently pray: “Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on Earth. Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father, we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory.”

Soon we will pray: “*Glory to God in the highest, and on Earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father.*”

During the proclamation of the Nicene Creed, we currently proclaim “We believe...” However, the Latin translation of “Credo” is “*I believe...*”, which will change when we switch to the new Missal. This reflects that each person comes to believe their own faith as an individual and each person must proclaim their belief in the faith as one individual.

These changes probably won't take effect until Nov. 2011. But they're coming! And it's time to prepare. For more information visit www.usccb.org/romanmissal/.
