### Fortnight for Freedom

The Fortnight for Freedom, which we celebrated for the first time last year, takes place from June 21 – the vigil of the Feasts of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More – to July 4, Independence Day. In 2013 we face many challenges to religious liberty, including the August 1, 2013 deadline for religious organizations to comply with the HHS mandate; potential Supreme Court rulings that could redefine marriage in June, causing serious religious liberty issues for Catholic adoption agencies and many others; and religious liberty concerns in other areas, such as immigration and humanitarian services. # INTRODUCING...

## Children's Liturgy of the Word



**WHO:** Children age 6 – 8 who have  
not yet made their First Communion

**WHEN:** Coming Fall 2013\*\*  
9:00am Mass at Holy Angels Church

Children's Liturgy of the Word has been a part of many parishes for decades. St. John the Baptist–Holy Angels Parish hopes to begin this program in the Fall of 2013 at the 9am Mass in Holy Angels Church.

Liturgy of the Word for Children is the practice of having the children leave the Sunday Assembly during the Liturgy of the Word and gather in a separate environment to engage in the Liturgy of the Word at a level more appropriate to the children's understanding. Their parents remain in the Sunday Assembly. The children return to their parent right before the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The purpose of making the liturgical experience more accessible to the assembled children is to nourish their faith experience and to affirm their value as important participants in the liturgy of God's Word.

What is the purpose of these specific celebrations of the Liturgy of the Word at Mass? The Liturgy of the Word for Children has, as its name suggests, a threefold purpose. It is a time to:

- ❖ engage in the public, communal rituals of the Church (Liturgy)
- ❖ listen to, break open, and respond to the scriptures (Word)
- ❖ celebrate the word in a way that children may understand (Children).

It is expected that Children's Liturgy of the Word will mirror the general structure and purpose of the Liturgy of the Word celebrated by the adult Assembly, but with the proclamation and breaking open of the scriptures adapted to meet the developmental stage and abilities of children.

Consequently, it is not intended to be a Sunday school or Scripture class. It is not a time for religious education or catechetical instruction. It is, furthermore, best suited to children of primary school age (6 – 8 who have not received First Communion yet), who generally have the capacity to listen to, and gain some understanding, of God's word. A program for younger children is held at the same time through the Religious Education Office (call 302/731-2209 for more information).

**\*\*Volunteers Needed:** We cannot start the program without volunteers.
