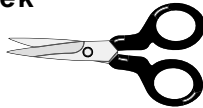

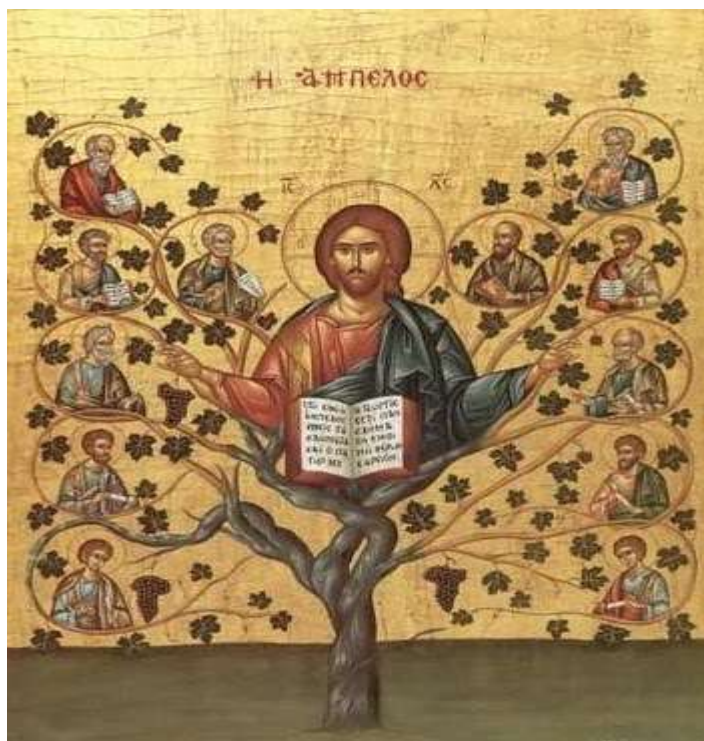
I lectura Hechos 9: 26-31
