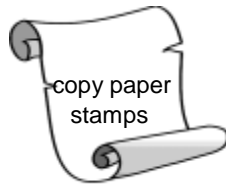
Please note that the Parish Center will be closed Thursday afternoon, November 17, for the monthly Staff Meeting.
