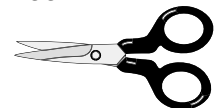

I Lectura Isaías 45:1, 4-6

Salmo Responsorial 95 "Aclamen la gloria y el poder del Señor"

II Lectura 1 Tesalonicenses 1:1-5b

Evangelio Mateo 22: 15-21

Los adversarios del Mesías se confabulaban para entramparlo y poder deshacerse de él, legítimamente. El pago del impuesto al emperador era asunto muy espinoso, porque aprobarlo significaba consentir una autoridad extranjera y pagana sobre el pueblo de Dios; negarlo podría resultar incendiario pues era como llamar a una revolución contra Roma.

Desde la intervención de los romanos en Palestina, en el año 63 a.C.; los lugareños habían tenido que pagar un pesado impuesto a los que habían sido sus tutores y protectores. Los tributos eran muy pesados para las familias palestinas. Se calcula que un 80% del ingreso anual de una familia de 8-10 miembros se gastaba solo en el pago de impuestos religiosos, locales.

Por sus palabras, Jesús deja claro que el César no es Dios, ni tiene estatus divino como sustentaba la propaganda imperial y el culto exigido por Roma.
