Social Concerns – Climate Change and *Laudato si*



Excerpt from message from *Catholic Climate Covenant*. "During Pope Francis's visit to the U.S., everyone was in a state of incredible excitement. The pope was here! It was a wonderful time to be close and to celebrate with people we hold dear. But now it's over. What do we do? We keep going. Pope Francis said something that will keep us going for a long time:

'... beyond our plans and programs, we are dealing with real men and women who live, struggle and suffer, and are often forced to live in great poverty, deprived of all rights.' If we focus on the work alone, and not on the reasons why we do it, then we are not dealing with real men and women who live, struggle and suffer. We are not receiving the spiritual nourishment that keeps us going. Work on ecology is not about saving the Earth. As Pope Francis helps us see, it is about healing our relationships with God, Creation, and each other.

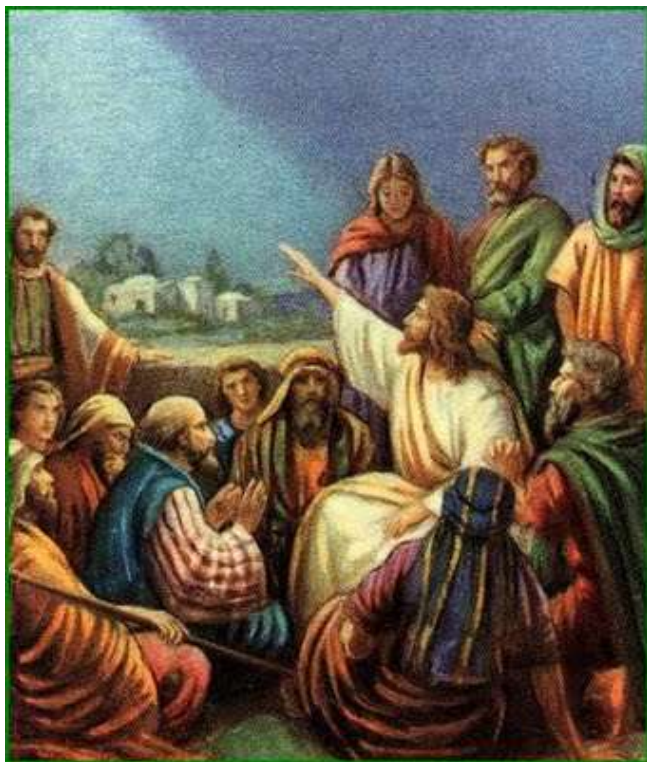
