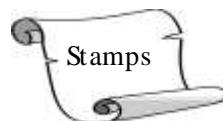

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) are women, men and young adults who assist the priest each week with the distribution of the Body and Blood of Christ. You must be 16 years of age or older, and a fully initiated Catholic in order to participate in this ministry. Participation requires attendance at a formation/training session conducted by the Diocese, and yearly formation meetings at the parish. The next Diocesan formation/training session will be held at St. Mark's High School on Tuesday, November 8, from 7:00 to 9:00 PM. 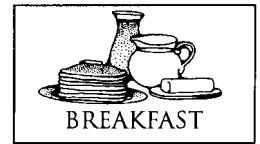
