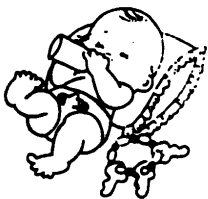

Delaware Repeal Project Presents

Sister Helen Prejean

Author of *“Dead Man Walking”*

Sr. Helen Prejean has been instrumental in sparking national dialogue on the death penalty and helping to shape the Catholic Church's newly vigorous opposition to state executions. Stationed in New Orleans, Sister became a spiritual advisor to a death row inmate at Angola Prison. After witnessing his execution, she wrote a book about the experience; *Dead Man Walking: An Eyewitness Account of the Death Penalty in the United States*. It has since become a movie, an opera, and a play for high schools and colleges.

Since 1984, Sister Helen has accompanied six men to their deaths, and these cases inspired her second book, *The Death of Innocents: An Eyewitness Account of Wrongful Executions*, published in 2004.
