The formal kick-off for the **Sustaining Hope for the Future** campaign is today at Holy Angels Church.

Our parish goal is \$854,000 over 3 years. The Diocese will receive 60% and our parish 40% of all funds received up to our goal. Campaign proceeds received after our goal is met will be 60% for the parish and 40% for our Diocese.

Our portion of the funds received will fund St. John Church refurbishment, Holy Angels School windows, completion of Holy Angels Church construction, and Joan Muzzi Athletic Building renovation.

A packet has been prepared for each parishioner and will be ready for you to pick up after Mass. The packet contains a letter which includes a specific dollar amount that the Bishop and Father Fiore would like you to prayerfully consider. Please review the campaign materials, pray about your response and continue to spread the positive message about this important effort!

The Pilgrimage begins at 1:00 PM with exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament and Holy Hour given by Rev. Andrew Apostoli, CFR. From 2:00 – 3:00 PM, there will be an opportunity for confession. 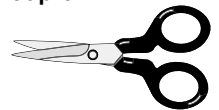
