Dear Parishioners,

The peace of the Lord Jesus be with you!

This has been an exciting week at St. John the Baptist Church. The high reach lift arrived at Main and Chapel to begin the necessary repairs to the cupola. I would like you to take a look at the digital photos of the cupola taken by Superior Building Services, Inc., the carpentry contractor for the project. The pics are on a display board in the back of St. John and Holy Angels Churches. Unfortunately once we were able to see the exterior of the cupola “up close and personal,” it wasn’t pretty. You can see that for yourself from the displayed photos.

The good news is that the infrastructure of the cupola is in good shape. However, 65% of the exterior wood needs to be replaced because it is warped, rotten, bowed and cupped. It is not possible to restore it.

Because of that assessment the base bid has been increased to \$26,184. This is a little over the original base estimate of \$15,000. Currently we have received \$16,755. I am so grateful for your generous response to the repair of St. John the Baptist steeple.

I would like to extend the request for St. John the Baptist Cupola Fund donations for another month. If you have not yet considered a donation to this important repair and preservation project, I hope you would give it some thought. We need only \$9459 more to have this project break even.

I am hoping that some of the Fall parish fundraisers will supplement the funds we need to complete this project and to provide seed monies for other necessary repair and maintenance projects for both St. John and Holy Angels churches. I hope you will participate in the various fundraising efforts that are currently announced in the parish bulletin.
