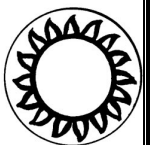

## XXI DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

### I Lectura Isaías 66: 18-21

### Salmo Responsorial . Salmo 117

“Vayan por el mundo y prediquen el Evangelio”

### II Lectura Hebreos 12: 5-7; 11-13

### Evangelio Lucas 13: 22-30

En el Evangelio de hoy, nos dice que Jesús se encamina a Jerusalén donde se cumplirá “su salida”. Todos sabemos lo que ocurrirá allá. Esto le da un tono grave a lo que va sucediendo en el camino. Jesús va enseñando, según se presente la ocasión. Ahora alguien le pregunta si son pocos los que se salvan. Jesús le responde con una imagen parabólica del Reino y unas palabras sobre la inversión escatológicas (13:30). La respuesta de Jesús quita toda creencia o idea de los fieles judíos que por nacer, crecer siendo miembros de la alianza con Dios tenían asegurado participar en el banquete del Reino. Sin embargo, en palabras de Jesús, entrar a dicho banquete les exigirá entrar por “la puerta estrecha”, por la de atrás. Esto implica despojarse primeramente de los “privilegios” que ellos mismos se han adjudicado, pero que mantienen alejados y excluidos de la salvación a los extranjeros incircuncisos.

El camino de Jesús a Jerusalén, promueve y realiza que todas las gentes participen en ese banquete.

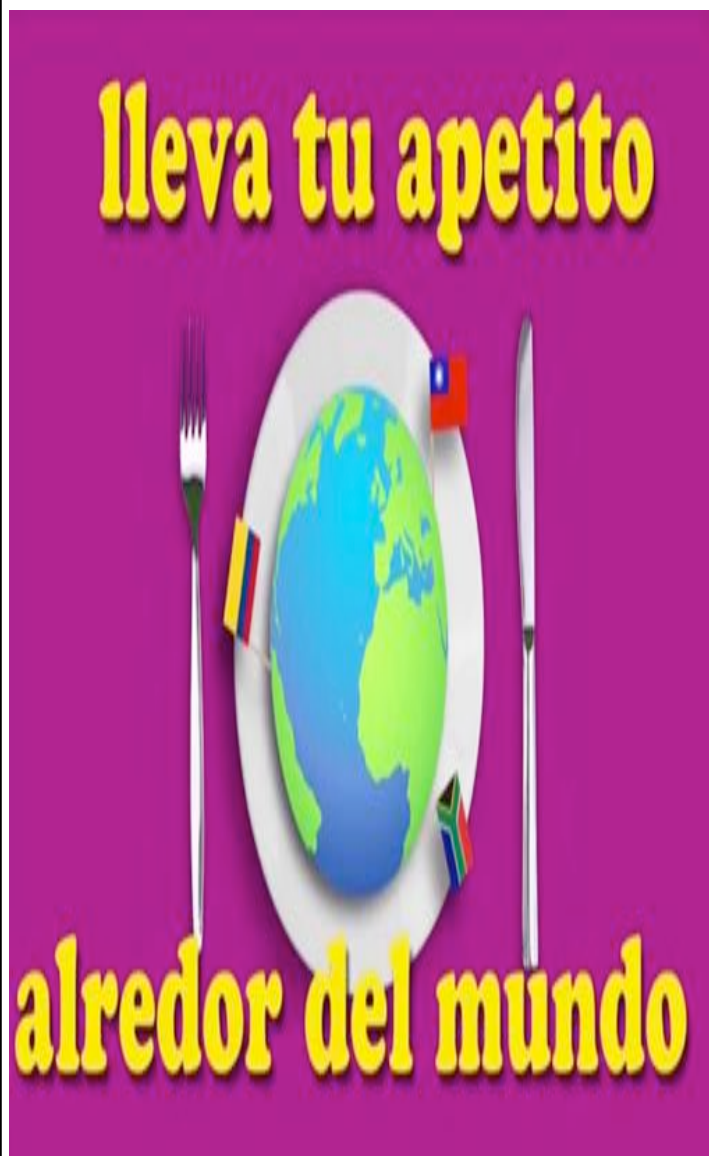
