To Fast means to <u>eat only one full meal during</u> <u>that day.</u> The other two meals should be smaller than the main meal. Also, no eating between meals. All persons ages 21 – 59 must fast on the required days.

Lent

To Abstain means to <u>refrain from eating meat</u> on the appointed day. All persons over the age of fourteen must abstain on required days.
