Did you know... 2 of 3 stroke victims have no prior symptoms or warnings! -- and -- Your doctor cannot order an ultrasound test unless you do have symptoms.

Prevention Health Screenings has been coming to our parish for the last 9 years. They offer 8 painless, non-invasive prevention screenings that could save your life. Test results are mailed to you, and you follow up with your own doctor.

Tests offered are:

1. Heart Disease Risk Screen via IMT
2. Stroke/Carotid Artery Screen
3. Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screen
4. Thyroid Screen
5. Peripheral Arterial Disease
6. Electrocardiogram (EKG)Screen
7. Pulmonary Function Screen
8. Bone Density-Osteoporosis

Adult Study

The Exodus story, with familiar characters and events, has been told and retold for thousands of years. It has been the topic of many an epic film. Yet, beyond the cinematic events, there is a growing awareness in Exodus of the saving presence of God, who liberates, redeems, calls, negotiates, forgives, and challenges. God forms a chosen people through Exodus. The Exodus is the foundational event that underlies Hebrew and Christian Scripture.

The study is not a lecture format. It is a prayerful, self-study of the selected materials that concludes each week with small group sharing and a video. The study will meet every Monday evening from 7:00 – 8:30 PM, until April 7.
