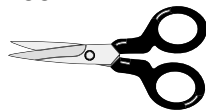

Primera lectura Isaías 8: 23-9:3

Salmo Responsorial 26 “El Señor es mi luz y mi salvación”.

Evangelio Mateo 4: 12-23

El Evangelio de hoy nos narra varios comienzos de la vida pública de Jesús. Jesús comienza a residir en Cafarnaúm, comienza a predicar, comienza a llamar discípulos y comienza a recorrer las sinagogas de la región.. Estos comienzos indican un horizonte de luz, como el mismo san Mateo indica al retomar al profeta Isaías. A quererlo o no, la imagen de la estrella guiando a los magos de Oriente viene a la mente. La luz brilla en la oscuridad.

El arresto de Juan motiva a Jesús a retirarse a Galilea, pero luego baja de la montaña para asentarse junto al lago Jesús anuncia el inminente reinado de Dios que exige conversión como Juan también predicaba. El Reino siembra esperanza en los galileos y va tomando forma en un grupo de seguidores, llamados por el mismo Jesús. Así desde el comienzo queda establecido que hacerse discípulo de Jesús solo tiene sentido en función del reinado de Dios. Seguimos a Jesús para aprender a caminar con él, a ser luz en la oscuridad, a reformular el proyecto de Dios sobre su pueblo, los que yacen en oscuridad y sombra de muerte. A eso está llamada la iglesia, a caminar con la luz del Evangelio.
