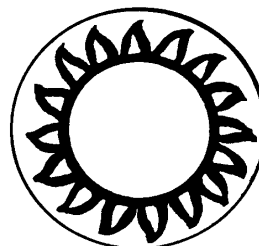

Summer Missionary Appeal

Our summer missionary appeal will be held next weekend, July 19/20, at all Masses. Brother Stanislaus Victor, CMSF, will speak on behalf of the Franciscan Mission Brothers in India. The Congregation of the Missionary Brothers of St. Francis of Assisi (CMSF) was founded in India in 1901 by a German Missionary, Brother Paulus Hermann Moritz. The Brothers minister in 12 countries, including India, Sri Lanka, Paraguay, Bolivia, Ghana and Kenya. They primarily work among the non-Christians, preaching the Gospel and bringing them to the Catholic fold. In addition to preaching the Gospel, the Brothers are trying to establish Catholic Elementary and High Schools, open new mission centers, provide potable water, work with rural women for their empowerment, encourage vocations and catechesis (parish ministry and religious education), work with leprosy and HIV/AIDS patients, sponsor children's homes/orphanages, homes for elders, and youth formation.

The second collection next weekend will go to the Franciscan Missionary brothers to be used for the missionary apostolate of the Congregation. In addition to your prayers for the continuation of the missionaries' good works, your generous contribution will be greatly appreciated.

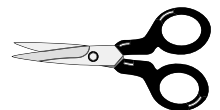
