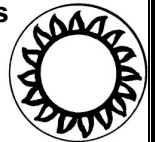

### Part-Time Coordinator of Youth Ministry

Immaculate Conception Parish, in Elkton, Maryland is in need of a part time Coordinator of Youth Ministry. The coordinator of youth ministry (CYM) is a 25 hour a week part time position with the possibility of becoming full time in the future. **I Lectura 1 Reyes 19: 16, 19-21**

**Salmo Responsorial . Salmo 16 “ Tú, Señor, eres el lote de mi heredad”.**

**II Lectura Gálatas 5:1, 13-18**

**Evangelio Lucas 9: 51-62**

**Antes, Simón develó la identidad del Ungido de Dios, y Jesús anunció su destino doloroso; luego pondra las condiciones para seguirlo. Ahora él decide ir al encuentro de ese sino ignominioso que le aguarda en Jerusalén, pero que yatoma forma con la hostilidad de los samaritanos.**

**Uno se hace cristiano no por asegurarse cobijo cuando el sol deja de calentar. El Hijo del hombre no tiene posesión ni seguridad que no sea la de la cruz. Jerusalem está adelante, el discípulo debe de caminar con el mismo arrojo y valentía por el Reino. O mejor dicho con la confianza total en Dios. Por otro lado, san Lucas resalta que la exigencia del Reino es mayor que la de los mismos deberes familiares, señalados en la primera tabla de la ley, es decir, la de los deberes con Dios. La radicalidad del seguimiento de Jesús es total. Pero es un seguimiento de cruz, que en este texto tiene forma de rechazo, de desarraigo familiar, de inseguridad y de pobreza absoluta por el Reino. No hay urgencia mayor que esa, no hay componendas ni interpretaciones; el Evangelio está claro. Hay que confrontarnos con la cruz y decidir por un modo de vida que haga presente a Dios en medio de nosotros.**
