**To Fast** means to <u>eat only one full meal during that day.</u> The other two meals should be smaller than the main meal. Also, no eating between meals. All persons ages 21 – 59 must fast on the required days.

**To Abstain** means to <u>refrain from eating meat</u> on the appointed day. All persons over the age of fourteen must abstain on required days.

#### **Lenten Vespers**

Spending just a little more time in prayer is a wonderful way to celebrate the Lenten Season. The Christians of the early Church devoted themselves to prayer at fixed times. It soon became the established practice to assign special times for common prayer; for example, the final hours of the day when evening draws on and the lamp is lighted. The Church's prayer at sundown is referred to as Vespers (or Evening Prayer). Vespers consists of hymns, psalms, prayers and Scripture, followed by a reflection.

Vespers is celebrated on the Sunday evenings of Lent at 6:30 PM at St. John Church. Please join us!



Volunteer of the Year This award is open to anyone 21 years of age or older who has been cleared for service in the Diocese and who is an outstanding volunteer with young people.

St. Timothy National Youth Award This award is given to a young person from the parish or school and is the highest recognition from the National Federation for Catholic Youth Ministry and CYM. This is a prestigious award given to a remarkable young person from our Parish.

St. John Bosco Award This is a diocesan award given to adult leaders (21 years and older cleared for service in the diocese) who have been involved in youth ministry for five or more years and have been positive role models in one of several categories. Recipients may be volunteer or salaried, lay or religious. An individual may be nominated from the following categories: parish or diocesan youth ministry, ministry in Catholic school, ministry as clergy or religious, ministry in athletics, ministry in catechesis, ministry in Girl Scouts, ministry in Boy Scouts, ministry to young adults, ministry in multicultural setting, and ministry in justice and service.

Companions on the Journey National Award Nominees may be adult volunteers, paid staff, or clergy (21 years or older and cleared for service in the diocese). This award is given to an individual who has provided three or more years of outstanding service to youth, in ministry in athletics, ministry in catechesis, ministry in Boy Scouts, ministry in Girl Scouts, ministry in justice and service, ministry to young adults, and parish youth ministry.
