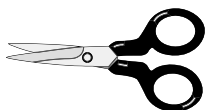

1ª lectura: Sabiduría 3: 1-9 “Las almas de los justos están en las manos de Dios”

Salmo Responsorial: 23 ‘El señor es mi Pastor, nada me falta’.

2ª lectura: Romanos 6: 3-9 “Todos hemos sido incorporados a Cristo Jesús por medio del bautismo.

Evangelio: Juan 6: 37-40

La voluntad de Dios es que nadie quede fuera de la salvación. Quien cree en el Hijo, está recibiendo un don del Padre (la fe) y este don incluye una vida nueva en toda su plenitud: La salvación y la resurrección. La forma típica de san Juan “no para...sino para” es una manera de precisar e indicar con toda claridad que el Padre es quien ha enviado al Hijo y vino para salvar y no para condenar.

La comprensión de nuestra vida a la luz de la fe en Cristo ha de situarnos en una perspectiva totalmente nueva en todo. De la salud y la enfermedad, del trabajo y el descanso, de nuestro origen y de nuestro destino. De nuestros difuntos y de nosotros mismos.

Con ocasión no de este texto sino de esta fiesta litúrgica, el Papa Benedicto XVI dijo unas palabras en el Ángelus del 5 de noviembre del 2006: Morir, en realidad forma parte de la vida y no solo de su final, sino también y prestamos atención, de todo instante. A pesar de todas las distracciones, la pérdida de un ser querido nos hace descubrir el “problema”, haciéndonos sentir la muerte como una presencia radicalmente hostil y contraria a nuestra natural vocación a la vida y a la felicidad.
