A Vocation Reflection

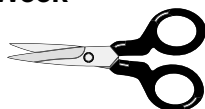

I Lectura Isaías 5: 1-7

Salmo Responsorial 79 "La viña del Señor es el pueblo de Israel"

II Lectura Filipenses 4: 6-9

Evangelio Mateo 21: 33-43

Dos aspectos del Evangelio pueden ayudarnos en la reflexión.
