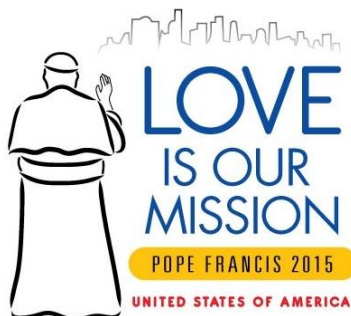
Registration/Informational meetings will be held on October 8 and November 3, at 7:00 PM in Holy Angels Church. Candidate and Parent must attend one of these meetings.

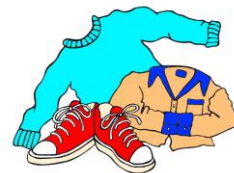
