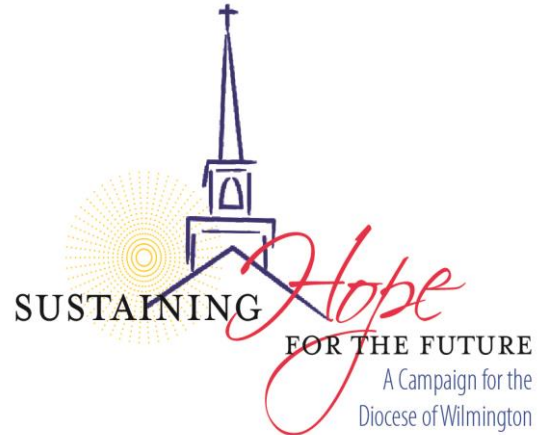

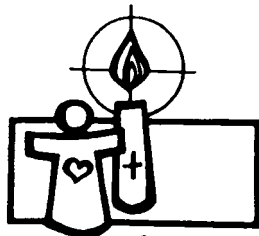

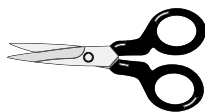
Soup's On! And we don't have any in the food pantry. Autumn and cooler temperatures are coming soon. We give out "tons" of soup to families. This item is a special

No se trata de hacer el bien, sino de hacerlo oportunamente. Este pasaje del Evangelio, está relacionado con la discusión que tiene Jesús con los jefes religiosos, de hecho, es a lo sumos sacerdotes y a los ancianos del pueblo a quienes se dirige la parábola. Igualmente probables que tenga relación con la siguiente parábola, en lo que se refiere a dar frutos.: “Por eso les digo que se les quitará el Reino de Dios para dárselo a un pueblo que rinda sus frutos”.

No solo hay que decir, sobre todo hay que practicar. De acuerdo a la parábola hacer la voluntad del padre, no es dirigirse a él de manera educada y bonita solamente; de hecho, el segundo hijo le dice “señor” una palabra que estaba reservada para que los esclavos se dirigiera a los amos.. es más, le promete obediencia pero ;no va En cambio ,el otro el otro hijo había respondido “no quiero” pero se arrepintió y fue. El que cumple la voluntad del papá es el que hace, no el que dice que hace. Pero el Evangelio va más allá todavía. No se trata de hacer algo, sino de “*ir a trabajar en la viña del Señor.*”
