Visitors For Christ

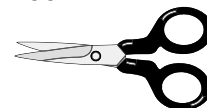
Visitors for Christ are men and women commissioned by the parish to serve and minister to the sick, the convalescing, the elderly and the homebound of our parish family.

II Lectura Apocalipsis 5: 11-14

Evangelio Juan 21: 1-19

En este relato el evangelista deja muy en claro que cuenta una manifestación de Jesús al grupo de siete discípulos. Cuenta pues una experiencia de salvación en la que Jesús muestra como Dios viene a socorrer al necesitado. Hasta que el hombre socorrido se da cuenta de que lo recibido no lo debe a sus esfuerzos ni a sus capacidades, sino a alguien más, cae en la cuenta de que alguien le guía misteriosamente; entonces se puede lanzar a realizar en su vida lo que Dios le pide, cuando se abre a la comunión. Ese es el punto del reconocimiento.
