Paschal Candle

The large candle that sits next to the Ambo has a very interesting history. It is lit and blessed for the first time at the

Easter Vigil. Evidence suggests that this began in the 4th century as written in a letter by St. Jerome in the year 384 to an Italian deacon. The solemn song of its praise, the "Exsultet," was composed about one hundred years later.

Initially the candle was broken up after the Vigil and its fragments given to the faithful. In the 12th century the custom began inscribing the current year on the candle as well as the dates of the Church's feasts that year. Therefore the candle grew in size; there are stories of candles weighing over 300 pounds!

It remains close to the Ambo during the 50 days of Easter and is lit for all liturgies. After Pentecost it is moved to the baptismal font, except for when it is lit during baptisms and funerals. The candle is placed next to caskets during funeral liturgies. This way, it symbolizes baptism as both a death and a resurrection in Christ, and also testifies to the Christian certainty of the resurrection of the dead.
