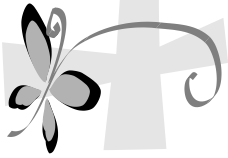


## Welcome!

The fulfillment of this mission is challenged by the geographic distance we encompass, and our large and ever-increasing membership and the diversity of needs among us.

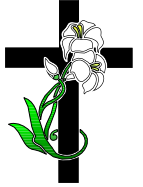
Through the grace of God, may we be strengthened to fulfill this mission.

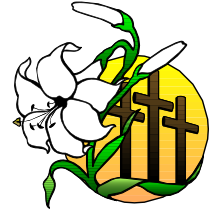

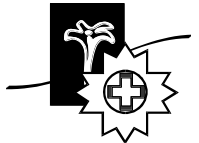

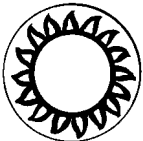

## Poster Contest

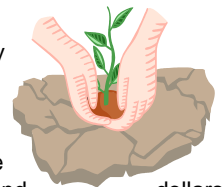

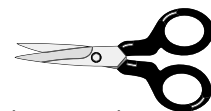
