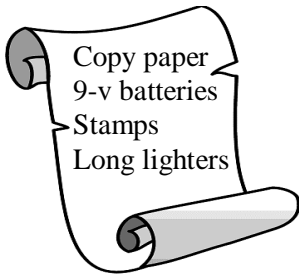

All athletes need to be registered with CYM (Catholic Youth Ministry). The website is [www.cdow.org](http://www.cdow.org). Scroll down the left hand column and click on "youth". Click on "athletics".

Click on "online registration.

**If you are a new user**, click on request user name and password and fill out the information.

CYM will email you a password within a few hours. After receiving your username and password, fill out the registration. CYM will then send you the 2010/2011 form that needs to be turned in to the Coach on or before the first practice.

**If you are not a new user**, enter your user name and password. Click on "edit my information" and change grade and/or any other information that needs to be updated.

CYM will email you the updated 2010/2011 form. Print and bring this form to the Head Coach on or before the first night of practice.

Athletes cannot practice without this form. Please make sure the "primary affiliation" reads "Holy Angels".

### Mission Appeal

August 7/8

As part of the U.S. Diocesan Missionary Cooperative Plan, the Society for the Propagation of the Faith invites a mission group each year to visit parishes in the United States to speak about the Mission Church. It is a chance for us to hear about what is going on with our brothers and sisters in other parts of the world and for missionaries to share their faith with us. This year the Diocese of Wilmington has invited representatives from the Diocese of Gonaives, Haiti to our parish. As you know, parts of Haiti were destroyed by a devastating earthquake last January. Haiti continues in a desperate situation. The country has 7 million people in an area smaller than Maryland. 70% of these cannot read and 85% live below poverty level. In slum areas, 4 out of 5 children do not reach the age of five, and nationally, 1 in 3 children is chronically malnourished.

The Diocese of Gonaives is home to more than one million of the poorest people on earth. The missionaries who will speak to us have first-hand experience in this diocese. They have spent time working among the poor Catholics in Haiti, at clinics that offer primary health care to mothers and infants, hospices for the dying, Catholic elementary schools and feeding programs. The Diocese of Gonaives faces very real needs in terms of the most basic things – food, water and shelter. We look forward to this opportunity to help our neediest brothers and sisters.

Please welcome Vince Gallagher and Charles Carr, volunteer missionaries to Haiti, to our parish next weekend. They will speak at both St. John and Holy Angels Churches.
