Online Giving – Progress Report

Top 5 Questions About the Program (So Far)?

1. How will it work? Enrollment will be simple. Parishioners will be asked to input their name, password, bank routing number, and weekly or monthly offertory amount.
2. Is it safe? Yes. Cathedral Corporation (our payment vendor) has been serving religious organizations for more than 90 years.
3. Can I make changes after I enroll? Yes. Changes can be made easily and in real-time.
4. Will it really make a difference? Yes. We all forget how many times we miss Mass at our home parish. Between vacation, business travel, illness, and important events throughout the year, we miss Mass more than we think. Most parishioners do not double up because they are in a weekly payment pattern and give to other churches when away.
5. How many people are really using electronic payments? According to the Federal Reserve 2009 study, 57% of all non-cash payments were made via ACH (electronic) and Debit Card.

What We Have Learned Along The Way (Recap)...

- Out of the 2500 families at SJHA, only 1200 (or 48%) contribute financial donations (2010 study).
- 117 families (out of the 1200) contribute 40% of all parish donations (2010 study).
- Parishioners, on average, missed Mass at SJHA more than 50% last year, according to their offertory envelopes (2011 study).
- About 20% of parishioners contribute monthly, not weekly (2011 study).
- 70% of all weekly / monthly donations are less than \$25 (2011 study).
- If Online Giving was implemented last year, the parish would have collected \$360,000 more in offertory donations. (assumes \$10 weekly donation x 1200 families x 30 missed Masses ... 2011 study).
