Election of Parish Trustees

The following is an excerpt from the State of Delaware Legal Code:

§ 105. Election of trustees.

The trustees shall be elected at a public meeting of the society or congregation, held at their usual place of worship, on 10 days notice by advertisements of such place and by a plurality of votes of the members present.

In accordance with Diocesan policy, the annual election of Parish Trustees will take place on Sunday, January 13, immediately following the 9:00 AM Mass at Holy Angels Church and the 10:00 AM Mass at St. John Church.
