Fourth Month of Life in the Womb

"The baby's brain has begun maturing – a process that will continue until he is about 14 years old. His eyelids are now sealed shut and will reopen at 7 months. His taste buds are now working. Nutrients consumed by his mother are passed on to him within an hour or two. Three hundred quarts of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on the head, eyebrows and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to the baby's parents can be seen at this time. This month, REMS (rapid eye movements) have been recorded – a sign of dreaming."
