## Why Join the Choir?

When congregational singing was introduced into Sunday liturgy in the 1960s, many musicians, clergy, and cradle Catholics thought that there would be no more need for a choir. As it turned out, however, choirs are needed more than ever! Liturgical documents highlight the choir's ministry, and pastoral experience has demonstrated the choir's importance in supporting the singing of the whole Assembly.

The primary role of the choir is to sing various parts of the Mass in dialogue or in alternation with the rest of Assembly. The choir's role is always understood to support the full, conscious, and active participation of the faithful gathered to pray, as called for by Vatican II.

To perform their liturgical function, choirs need plenty of voices and rehearsal; for it is only when the music is well-prepared that the choir can really support the singing of the whole Assembly. Careful preparation is also needed if choral singing is to express the mystery of God through beauty, and if it is to foster the dignity of the liturgical celebration.

## Loyola Institute Advanced Studies Program

The Diocesan Office for Religious Education plans to offer advanced studies in Religious Education and Pastoral Studies through the Loyola Institute for Ministry Education (LIMEX) program of Loyola University, New Orleans. This educational process is carried out in learning groups; each course is led by a LIMEX certified facilitator. Sessions for each course employ a design in which lectures in printed form and other required and suggested readings are correlated with the participant's experience by means of reflective processes. Videotapes that present mini-lectures by well-known scholars enhance class sessions. Learning groups are made up of students with a variety of interests and goals. The learning process seeks to nurture and provide opportunities to practice skills related to the performance of ministry.
