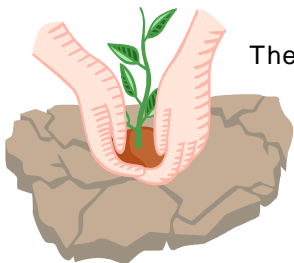
**Environment Committee – Linens**

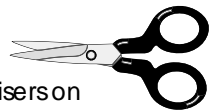
