### Come Grow With Us!

We are pleased to announce the creation of "Holy Angels Community Garden" in the area behind the Parish Center. The garden was blessed by Father Ralph on May 15<sup>th</sup>. The 20 plots have been planted by their owners with tomatoes, eggplant, peppers, cucumbers, etc. Two of the plots are designated as true "community plots" with the produce to be given to needy families.

It has taken a year to reach this point. Gustavo tilled the 50'x100' area and mixed in mushroom soil. He and his helpers erected a fence to keep out the wildlife. Deacon Heriberto hooked up a temporary watering system. Alexander's donated mulch. Miguel mulched the main garden pathway. Lois and Marie planted vegetables in the "community garden" plots. Walter Carpenter State Park donated a rustic-looking kiosk (message board). And many others labored industriously. It truly is a community garden and a joy to see. Take a walk up the hill and see it for yourself! We get excited with each new sprout and rejoice in the Lord.

It does "take a village to raise a garden". If you can't garden yourself, be a part of our joy.
