

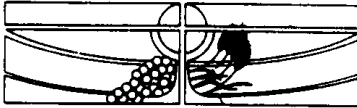

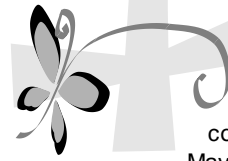

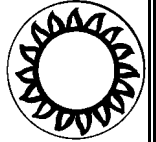

Only a few lots left



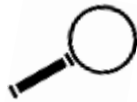

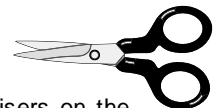
