Dear Parishioners,

May the continuing joy of Easter and the Risen Christ be with you!

The very first person that I ran into when I returned from Italy was our maintenance supervisor, John Arena. The second thing out of his mouth after "welcome home" was "we have a major sink hole on the school grounds and it's big enough to put a car in and its growing".

That was last week. This past week, on Tuesday, the excavator was more than ten feet down and discovered an eight-inch drain pipe had not been properly capped off before it was buried; another section of a twelve-inch main stormdrain was found fourteen feet down, not joined to other drain pipes and was broken with water flow eroding and undermining the soil above the pipe. This problem area is near the school playground. The problems of drainage pipes and runoff as well as mislaid sewer and drain lines have plagued us since last summer. Since last August we have spent more than \$46,000 to fix these problems. Part of the current problem is the aging of drainage and sewer pipes - installed when the school was built (1956) – and improper installation and flow – when Holy Angels Church was built (2004).

It is extremely difficult to forge a path forward with our Maintenance Ministry when we are attending to such fundamental infrastructure needs of our buildings and grounds. The Maintenance Ministry previously had outlined a plan to facilitate the completion of some areas of Holy Angels Church – viz. another meeting area and a space for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I would like those plans to move forward.

You may have noticed posters in both St. John and Holy Angels Churches displaying the current projects for the new Guardian Angels meeting room and the Reconciliation Room. Those projects are estimated to cost \$35,000.

We need your help and support to bring these projects to completion. There are envelopes available at the poster sites in both churches. We have been so successful in completing projects both at St. John and Holy Angels-the Cupola was the first project completed, due to your generosity and spirit of sacrifice.

I hope that we will continue on this successful path to be faithful to the patrimony of St. John-Holy Angels and assume our stewardship responsibilities as members of this faith community.

Thank you for concern and care for our parish. Together we can build a strong and secure future for our faith community here in Newark.
