### A Vocation Reflection The Ascension of the Lord

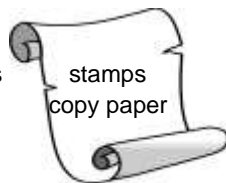

Primera lectura Hechos 1: 12-14

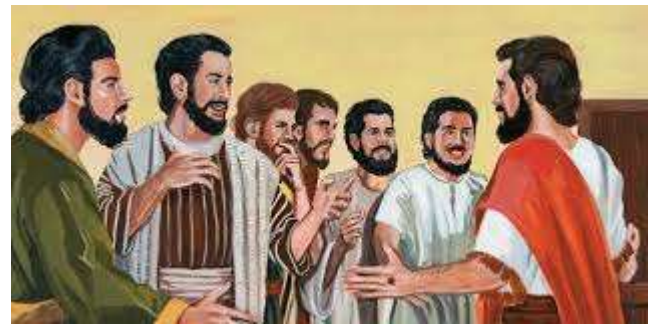
Salmo Responsorial 26 “Espero gozar de la dicha del Señor, en el país de la vida”.

Segunda lectura 1 Pedro 4: 13-16

Evangelio Juan 7: 1-11

Los discursos de despedida de Jesús cierran con una solemne plegaria dirigida al Padre. Esta oración explica los eventos de la partida de Jesús: son eventos de gloria, de honor recíproco entre Padre e Hijo. Igualmente, la oración apunta la fe discipular, indicando la distancia respecto a los que no creen en Jesús, y solicita la unidad a todo el grupo. Esto último, la unidad, es uno de los motivos más saliente de esta oración.

La primera parte de la lectura de hoy expone la unidad entre Jesús y su Padre, están unidos en la gloria. El segundo momento enfoca a los discípulos. El grupo es también espacio de unidad entre Padre e Hijo; lo comparten, por así decir; es de ambos. El grupo ha recibido la revelación de Jesús, la atesora, y al hacerlo reconoce la unidad entre Dios y su enviado.
