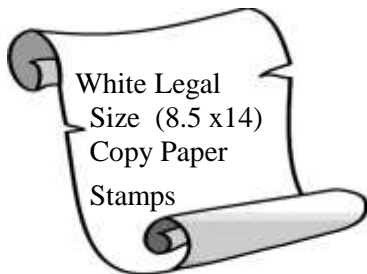

## Important Notice

On Sunday morning November 6 Holy Angels Church experienced another electrical fire in the dimmer lighting control box in the electrical room of the building. The control box controls the operation of the lighting for the Sanctuary area of Holy Angels Church. We are currently working with the manufacturer to find a solution and answers as to what has caused a reoccurrence of a similar problem we had about a year ago.

All lights within the Sanctuary have to be manually turned on by breakers except for the inside perimeter lighting around the inside of the church, which are still controlled by the panel at the entrance to the Sanctuary. We ask for your patience over the next few weeks while work is being done to locate the problem and eliminating it from reoccurring in the future.

Also, any function taking place in the Sanctuary during the evening will only have the inside perimeter lighting available until further notice. The lighting in all other areas around the church has not been affected by this fire and is working as usual.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this might cause.
