What is Lectio Divina?

“There are many kinds of Christian meditation, but above all is listening to God through the scriptures, ruminating on the Word, a deep conversation of hearing and responding. In meditation we read not just for information; we probe, ponder, and explore so that the words of Scripture become for us the Word of God in our lives. ...

There is another level of meditative scripture reading: to ask, “What is it saying to me? Does the text have a ‘word’ for me in this day and time?”

These words from E. Glenn Hinson in *The Mind of Christ* express beautifully what happens when we meet for Lectio Divina. Using the 4 R’s of Read, Reflect, Respond, Rest, we focus on the Gospel Reading for the following Sunday.

Supermarket Gift Card Program
