Lay Presiders at St. John-Holy Angels

Last July, Bishop Malooly, in stating his priorities for the Diocese of Wilmington in The Dialog, wrote that Priority One was to “develop new models for parish structure and administration promoting vibrant and collaborative parish leadership, integrating the gifts of both laity and clergy... Given the shortage of priests we must both encourage vocations to the priesthood and also take steps to relieve the priest of duties others can perform so that he is about the work of his sacred ministry.”

Our Pastor, Fr. Fiore supports the above initiative given to us by Bishop Malooly. How can we as parishioners here at St. John-Holy Angels lend our support to the Bishop's first priority?

Perhaps Step One will be to try to keep an open mind to the possibilities, recognizing that the laity has been given not only the authority, but also the support of the clergy to preside at some liturgical functions. It is definitely a change to have someone other than the ordained lead us in worship. It might take us out of our comfort zone, just as the first Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist did so long ago. It is not what we are used to seeing, but this shift does come with full approval and will be of help and support to our priests.

Here at our parish we have had lay presiders for Vespers, which is part of the Liturgy of the Hours, for several years during Advent and Lent. Lay presiders have also been asked to lead the Stations of the Cross. When necessary, they have also presided at Eucharistic Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest, for example when all the priests of the Diocese gathered for retreat.

This year more lay presiders are currently in formation in our parish. They are preparing to lead us in worship and prayer. They come as servants. Let us hold them in prayer as they embrace the responsibility of this ministry, and may we all accept them with welcoming hearts. © 2012, Mary R. Consiglio

The girls made shirts at their last troop meeting to promote their troop and support the cause. They completed the full walk and also participated in the many activities at the event.



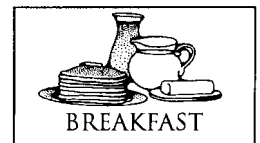
