## Interested in Becoming an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (Eucharistic Minister)?

## Fall Bible Series

**"Gospel of Mark"  
 begins October 9**

**Sundays, 6 PM–7:20 PM**

We are taking on the Gospel of Mark! Most scholars believe that Mark's is the earliest Gospel. Mark's Gospel is recorded after the destruction of the temple and the end of the Jewish revolt against the Romans. Mark's voice is found amidst the chaos and destruction. Mark teaches that Jesus is the fulfillment of the words of the prophets who warned of the temple's destruction. Who is this Jesus and what does his life and death mean for us?

We cannot appreciate the Gospel of Mark unless we study the parallels Mark used; parallels and references to the Old Testament whose meanings were fully understood by the early Christian communities. Mark stresses to the new community the meaning and cost of discipleship; an enduring problem that begs to be rediscovered by Christians of every era and circumstance.

We will use the Little Rock Scripture Study program as our guide as we pray, reflect and share our understanding of the Gospel of Mark. Sessions begin October 9 and end on Sunday, Dec. 18. With the beginning of Advent 2011, we, as Catholics, will be experiencing revisions in our Mass. The revisions will be in our responses, the words that we say in the Gloria and Creed, and in the prayers, which the priest will say during Mass. These revisions will mirror more closely an accurate translation from the original Latin text.

It will take time for us to acclimate ourselves to the revisions. This, however, is a time for us to deepen our understanding of the Mass and to renew our love for the Eucharist which draws us together as faith communities week after week.

Over the next several months, we will be offering a series of short bulletin articles to renew us throughout the parish as we prepare for the revisions. It is our hope that the articles will nourish us as the faithful and nurture us on our journey together.
