### Holy Angels Church Entrance Doors

One of the visual needs of the Parish about which we have received some questions is the main entrance doors of Holy Angels Church. These exterior doors are made of wood, and after 9 years of use and weather, are visibly beaten.

Over time, the Parish has plans to replace ten of the exterior doors of Holy Angels Church with durable metal doors that look like the existing wooden doors. The first set of four doors, for the main entrance, will be ordered soon at a cost of \$13,000, which includes reusing the existing handles and hinges. The manufacturer requires a deposit of \$5,000 and once the new doors are ordered, it will take ten to twelve weeks to receive them. The new doors are insulated and will have a significantly longer lifespan than the existing wooden doors.

If you would like to help us purchase these doors, and are able to make a donation, simply put your donation in a plain white envelope and mark it “Entrance Doors”. There are also some envelopes in the Gathering Space. You can drop your envelope in any collection basket. This would be greatly appreciated.
