Natural Family Planning (NFP) Classes

Natural Family Planning (NFP) is an umbrella term for certain methods used to achieve and postpone pregnancies. NFP reflects the dignity of the human person within the context of marriage and family life, promotes openness to life, and recognizes the value of the child. By respecting the love-giving and life-giving natures of marriage, NFP can enrich the bond between husband and wife. Natural Family Planning classes are taught by members from the Couple to Couple League in a series of 3 classes. The Fall 2012 classes will be held at St. Margaret of Scotland in Newark, DE. Class dates are September 15, October 13 and November 17 at 1:00 PM. The method taught, Sympto-thermal, is safe and highly effective. Pro-Life Workshop

The Diocese of Wilmington is sponsoring a workshop for parish pro-life leaders and anyone else who would like to attend. It will be held at St. Polycarp Parish in Smyrna on Saturday, September 29. Registration begins at 9:00 AM and the program is from 10:00 AM – 2:30 PM.

Keynote speaker will be Matt Franck of the Witherspoon Institute in Princeton; his address will be "Life and Liberty in a Secular Age." Matt Franck is Professor Emeritus of Political Science at Radford University in Virginia. He is a widely published author and his areas of interest include constitutional law and the judiciary in addition to issues of life and marriage.

Also included in the workshop is celebration of Mass and various sessions on end of life issues, the difference between intrinsic evils and matters of prudential judgments, Rachel's Vineyard, best practices for your local Respect Life Committee, and end of life issues.
